Contributions	2026 Employee Contributions IRS Limit: \$24,500 Catch-up Limit (age 50 and up): \$8,000 Higher Catch-up Limit (age 60-63): \$11,250	- Through automatic payroll deduction, you may now contribute up to 75% of your eligible pay on a pretax and/or Roth after-tax basis up to the IRS limit. - Depending on your age or other factors, you may be able to make "catch-up" contributions. If your 2025 FICA wages exceed \$150,000*, any catch-up contributions you make in 2026 must be Roth. - In addition, you can automatically increase your retirement savings plan contributions each year through the Annual
	Employer Contributions	✓ The LCMC Clinics 401(k) Plan will match your contributions 100% up to 3% and 50% on the next 2% of pay that you defer to the Plan.
Vesting	Employee Contributions	You are always 100% vested in your own contributions to the LCMC Clinics 401(k) Plan.
	Employer Contributions	You are always 100% vested in your employer's contributions to the LCMC Clinics 401(k) Plan.
Loans	Although your plan account is intended for the future, you may borrow from your account for any reason.	
Withdrawals	Withdrawals from the Plan are generally permitted when you terminate your employment, reach age 59½, become permanently disabled or have severe financial hardship, as defined by your plan.	
	When you leave the LCMC Clinics 401(k) Plan, you can withdraw contributions and any associated earnings from the Plan. Or, you can leave contributions and any associated earnings in the Plan.
